Your Guide to Identification & Entitlement To Work



PART 1 – Guidance for the ‘Identification’ section of your Key Portfolio Application Form

1.1 Certification of your ID documentation

The copy of your photographic ID must be certified as a true likeness by a responsible adult such as a teacher, doctor, recruitment agency worker, etc. They must sign and date the copy.

1.2 Alternative ID options if you do not have a valid passport

The table below allows you to identify alternative ID options based on your nationality. If you are unsure which group your nationality falls into, refer to Section 1.3 below.

Nationality Group	Alternative ID Options (certified copies only)
UK & Common Travel Area Nationals	Official document containing your name & permanent NI number* & One of: <u>Full</u> UK Birth OR Adoption Certificate
All other European Union Nationals**	National ID Card OR Residence Permit
All Other Nationalities	Please disregard the ‘Identification’ section of the Application Form and proceed to the ‘Nationality’ section

*This could be either a document issued by a previous employer, such as a P45 or P60, or a document issued by a UK Government Agency, providing it has your full name and permanent NI number printed on it.

1.3 Confirmation of Nationality Groups

UK Nationals & Common Travel Area Nationals:

Scotland, England, Northern Ireland, Wales, The Republic of Ireland, The Channel Islands, The Isle of Man.

All other European Union Nationals:

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, The Republic of Ireland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland.

** For the purposes of this Document Guide, all European Union and other countries subject to the same immigration procedures and checks, have been incorporated into this group.

All Other Nationalities:

If you are not a national of any of the countries listed above please proceed to the ‘Nationality’ section of the Application Form as all the documentation you need to supply will be covered in this section.

PART 2 – Guidance for the ‘Nationality’ section of your Key Portfolio Application Form

2.1 Dual Nationality

If you are a Dual National and **neither** of your nationalities is British, please submit a copy of the identification page of **one** of your passports. If you need a visa to work in the UK we must also receive a copy of your Entitlement to Work document.

If you are a Dual National and **one** of your nationalities is British, please provide copies of the identification pages of **both** your passports.

2.2 Alternative Entitlement to Work (ETW) options

In addition to these requirements detailed below, the Border and Immigration Agency require that you provide to Key:

- 1 A copy of the front or cover page of your passport
- 2 A copy of any other page of your passport containing a UK Government endorsement
- 3 A copy of the ID page of your passport, if not included in the documents already requested

A2 Accession States (Bulgaria & Romania)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Worker Authorisation Card / Certificate OR ■ Registration Certificate confirming your entitlement to work
All Other Nationalities (including Dual Nationals who do not hold a UK or European Union Passport)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Appropriate Biometric Immigration Document OR ■ Application Registration Card OR ■ Appropriate Work Permit & either: The ID & endorsement pages of your national passport OR An official letter confirming your entitlement to work status OR ■ Official document indicating your name and permanent NI number & either: Suitable Immigration Status Document OR Certificate of Registration, or Naturalisation, as a British Citizen OR Appropriate letter from the UK Government
Family Member of a European Union National	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Permanent Residence Card OR ■ Certificate of Application (less than 6 months old) from the UK Government
